

Module B – Taking The Lead

Ice Breaker (10 mins) – Human Connect 4 (or 3!)

- Set up grid of chairs according to No. participants
- Non Leader led at first (i.e. no consultation with team)
- Leader led; one participant in charge
- Use spare symbols on paper if not enough participants

Introduction (5 mins) – Aims and Objectives

Goldfish Bowl (Brainstorm) (10 mins)

- Outline of good and bad leadership qualities
- Pre-prepared answers could be 'stuck up' on wall
- Flipchart

Questionnaire/Quick Fire Assessment Sheet (10 mins)

- Research to come up with questions that will lead to YLs being able to identify their leadership style (pcsi model)

Discussion of Leadership Styles (20 mins)

- As it says on tin! (4 types dominantly)
- Need to be able to change style
- Style appropriate to Section
- Do not label!

Role Play of Leadership Styles (10 mins)

- 2 x scenarios (or more to keep bigger group involved) run in parallel small groups
- Each scenario will be performed in 2 leadership styles (appropriate and inappropriate)
- Role play led by adult Leader, YLs take part
- Section specific to be considered

Case Studies (Library of case studies to be developed) (10 mins)

- 2 case studies
- Identify which leadership style they would/wouldn't use
- Adapt no. to group nos.

Game (10 mins)

- N,S,E,W → are leadership styles
- Questions/scenarios are read out
- YLs have to decide on appropriate style + move to correct area of hall
