Method

Monitoring success

Record keeping

Plenary – 5 minutes

Have 10 piles of cards which have statements of the various things which records could be kept of. Ask participants to go into small groups and look through the cards and pull out the information that should be kept about the Young Leaders.

Plenary - Discussion 10 minutes

Presenter to then read out the list and see if there are any differences from other groups
