

Humberside Explorer Scout Monopoly Run



Date of event: 26 - 28 June 2009

Humberside Explorer Scouts would like to invite you to join them as they play the Hull edition of Monopoly on a grand scale. This event is open to teams of 4-5 Explorer Scouts, Scouts or mixed teams with prizes being awarded for taking part and completing the game.

After leaving 'GO' teams will use their score sheet to navigate around places within the Hull City Centre area. At each location the teams will answer questions, complete tasks and take part in challenges to earn points. For example- 'fit as many people into a phone box as possible and take a photo'.

Teams can also use the day for shopping and/or visiting the local free museums such as the Ferens Art Gallery, Maritime Museum, Streetlife Museum and Wilberforce House. However, teams have a time limit to complete the Monopoly Run so are advised not to hang about too long.

The cost of the event is only £20 per person and this pays for the entry fee into the competition, transportation into Hull and back to Raywell Park on the Saturday, camping fees as well as certain meals (see below).

Teams and leaders will have to eat before they arrive on Friday and have sufficient money to buy meals in Hull during the day. However, Saturday and Sunday breakfast as well as a light evening meal on Saturday will be provided.

This is a joint Explorer/Scout event and participants should be over 12 and under 18 on the day of the event. Teams must consist of 4-5 Explorers/Scouts wearing neckers at all times.

It is the responsibility of the Unit/Troop Leader to ensure that their teams are confident and competent to travel independently in Hull, and that permission has been granted from team members' parents/guardians to do so.

Each team will need a digital camera with a USB cable that fits the camera you are using (camera phones may not be used as software is needed to connect them to computers) and at least two mobile phones (with credit). Teams will also need their own camping equipment including a tent.

Travel in Hull is by foot only. Use of cars, bikes, taxis or public transport is not permitted. However, people with mobility disabilities may request the use of minibuses by contacting the organising team.

Explorer and joint Scout/Explorer teams must be independent during the activity. However, teams of just Scouts may take part in the Monopoly Run with a leader accompanying them, if required.

Teams are to arrive from 7pm on the Friday evening at Raywell Park (Humberside Scouts HQ) in the BP building and on the Sunday morning we expect to leave the site by 12 noon.

The entry form should be completed by the Troop/Unit leader only and should be returned with the permission forms and cheque to Monopoly Run c/o Raywell Activity Centre by 9th June – please enclosed a stamped addressed envelope (no late bookings will be accepted).

From 1st May teams from anywhere in the North East region are welcome to enter the event!

Cheques should be made payable to 'Humberside Scout Council' and cash won't be accepted.

You can also help to make this event even better by spreading the word and getting your Explorer/Scout friends to sign up. The more teams taking part the bigger and better the challenge!
