



### **Briefing for POL presentations**

There are three presentations available for Programmes Online and each have different functions.

#### **POL Interactive**

This presentation is best used when you have access to a number of computers (with Internet access) that people can use at the same time as you are running the presentation. It give people the opportunity to try out POL in a safe environment. It is recommended that there are two or three of you available – one to do the presentation and the others available to help the participants with any problems or difficulty they have with the process that you are going over.

Before the day it is a good idea to ask people to register to use POL so that they can use their own login. It is sensible for the presenter and the helpers to have a play with POL before hand, enter some activities, search for activities, and build a programme so that you all know how it works.

#### **POL Non Interactive**

This presentation is best used when you are unable to use other computers. It is very similar to the above presentation.

#### **POL Scrolling**

This presentation is most suitable for when you don't have the opportunity to give a presentation, but have the opportunity for a presentation to be running on its own. It is on a loop so will continue going around until you stop it.
