Fast Track Fund

Grants for immediate training costs

CAF (Charities Aid Foundation) have started to take applications for 2003-04. CAF aims to improve the infrastructure of small to medium sized **registered charities**. Priority will be given to organisations with incomes less than £50,000 a year. Only one grant application available in one year (between May and April) of **up to £600**.

The Fast Track Fund will make grants to **support immediate training costs only**. The focus must be on strengthening the structure of your organisation e.g. financial management, fundraising or training for volunteers.
