This trust is one of the few that offers no information on the criteria by which grants are decided. Consequently this trust does receive a large number of applications. The trust had a grant total of £2.7m in 2000/01 and the beneficial area is unrestricted.

Grants are considered regularly, however grants will only be made to **registered charities**. There is no application form, but a covering letter to the Director should be included with the **latest audited report and accounts**.

The covering letter should include details on:

- A description of what the charity does and what its objectives are
- An explanation of the need and purpose of the project
- How much will the project cost (this needs to be itemised)
- The size of the grant requested
- How much has already been raised and from whom. How is it planned to raise the shortfall?
- If applicable, how the running costs of the project will be met, once the project is established
- Any other documentation that is felt relevant
